

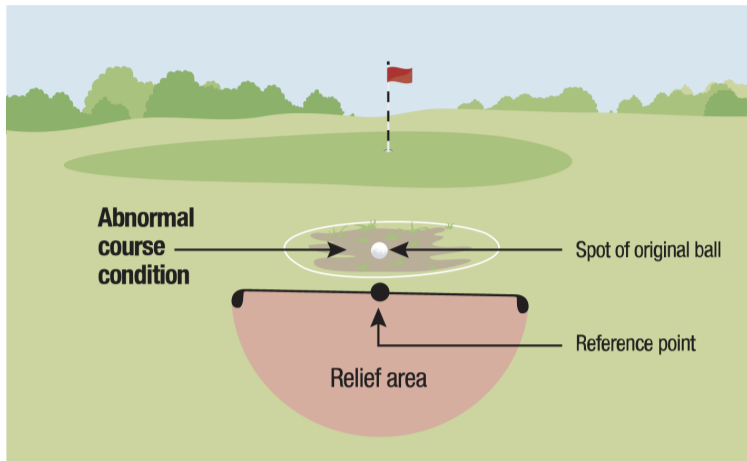
LOCAL RULES



ROCK WALL ON HOLE 1 RELIEF OPTIONS

Relief may be taken under rule 16.1b

If the rock wall interferes with your stance or swing the player may take FREE relief by dropping the ball in the relief area illustrated.



Mark the ball, find closest reference point no closer to the hole where the wall does not interfere with your stance or swing. Mark that spot, the ball may now be dropped within 1 club length either side or behind the reference point no closer to the hole.

LOST BALL OR OUT OF BOUNDS LOCAL RULE E5

When a player's ball has not been found i.e. "lost" or is known to be out of bounds the player may proceed under stroke and distance local rule for a penalty of 2 strokes rather than only the stroke and distance rule of 1 shot penalty.

If the ball is not found there are two estimated reference points

1. The point where the original ball is estimated to have last crossed the boundary of OB or edge of LONG GRASS
2. Fairway reference point. The point of Fairway of the hole being played that is nearest to the ball reference point but no nearer the hole.

Limits of location of relief area

Must be in the general area and no nearer the hole than the ball reference point.

Once the player puts a ball into play under this local rule the original LOST or OB ball is no longer in play and must not be played even if found within the 3 minute search time (see rule 6.3b)

The player may not use the option to take relief when

1. The ball is known or certain to have come to rest in a penalty area
2. The player has played another ball provisionally under stroke and distance (see rule 18.3)

If the ball is found within the 3 minute search time, that ball must be played. If it is declared unplayable the player may proceed under rule 19.

ENVIRONMENTAL HAZARD PENALTY AREA

The southern wetland is defined as an environmental area. You are NOT permitted to enter this area to play your ball or to retrieve your ball.

Proceed under rule 17.1c - Relief options are:

1. 2 club length drop from point of entry no nearer the hole for a 1 shot penalty
2. Drop another ball back on the line of entry no nearer the hole anywhere on a line between the hole and the estimated point of entry for a 1 shot penalty.

3. Replay shot from original position for a 1 shot penalty

If your ball lies outside the penalty area but your feet are in the penalty area you are required to take relief. Drop the ball with full relief from penalty area within 1 club length no nearer the hole for

NO penalty.

BALL UNPLAYABLE BEHIND RETAINING WALL, AGAINST CLUB HOUSE OR BUGGY SHED ON 18TH HOLE

You may take FREE relief in these circumstances and proceed under rule 16.1

1. Mark the ball. Relief must be taken at nearest point of relief from where your ball is marked. Either side of the obstruction.
2. The nearest point of complete relief (reference point) should be identified and the ball must be dropped in and come to rest in the relief area. The Relief area is 1 club length either side or behind the reference point, is not nearer the hole (refer above illustration). There is NO penalty.

IMMOVALE OBSTRUCTION CLOSE TO PUTTING GREENS

A player may take free relief under rule 16.1b if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play when intending to putt AND is within two club lengths of the putting green, AND within 2 club lengths of the ball.

No relief is to be given if line of play clearly is unreasonable.

WINDMILL RELIEF RULE

There is no relief from line of site & if your ball strikes the Windmill the ball is in play wherever it lands.

If the Windmill interferes with your swing or stance the nearest point of complete relief should be identified and the ball must be dropped in & come to rest in the relief area. The Relief area is 1 club length either side or behind the reference point, is not nearer the hole (refer above illustration). There is NO penalty.

DOUBLE GREEN - HOLES 14 and 16

Rule 25-3 (Wrong Putting Green) does not apply to the double green shared by holes 14 and 16.

Balls lying on the "wrong" side of the green may be putted from where they lie or the player may take relief in accordance with Rule 25-3 by dropping the ball off the green without penalty.
