After a career in business journalism, public relations, marketing and investor relations, Richard retired in 2014, However, he was subsequently engaged in June 2015 as inaugural manager of golf shop operations for the newly opened 9-hole Maleny Golf Club which he joined as a financial member in 2004.

Richard was responsible for building up a roster of volunteers to staff the golf operation and establishing the retail and sales business from a standing start. Journalistic and communications skills were fundamental for promotion of the club in the absence of an advertising budget.

Richard resigned from the role in December 2017 but has continued to work in the club's interests as a member of the Marketing Sub-committee, providing professional advice and support to promote the club, raise its public profile and enhance its brand awareness.
