Rob was born and raised in Brisbane, has lived in Maleny since the mid-1980s and spent most of his working life as a self-employed tradesman specialising in French Polishing and furniture restoration.

In 1999 Rob attended the very first meeting involving a small group hoping to build a golf course in Maleny, but little did any of them know that it would be another 16 years before they would be able to open the first nine holes.

In 2004 Rob became a member of the Maleny Golf Club Committee and remained on the committee until 2017.

He was heavily involved during 2014/15 in construction of the first nine holes and, as the club only had a greens staff of one, he assisted in course maintenance and the greens mowing. On the opening of the golf course Rob became the club's first Green's Director.

In 2017 Rob again worked alongside our Superintendent on construction of the next three holes (now 4, 5 and 6). He rejoined the Management Committee in 2019 as Green's Director and again became involved in construction of the remaining six holes, the revetted bunkering and the dry stone walls.

Rob is very proud of the great golf course we have today and, as one of the many volunteers who have been involved in the evolution of the club, believes the club can continue to grow even more into the future.
